Kudingo v. Barrett L.C.#2009CF498

On May 5, 2022, the court issued an order stating that this matter would be subject to dismissal under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83 unless, within ten days of the date of the order, the petitioner, Anthony T. Kudingo, paid the \$195.00 filing fee or showed good cause for a waiver of prepayment of fees and costs by filing certain required paperwork.

On May 13, 2022, the court issued an order dismissing this matter, without prejudice, on the ground that Mr. Kudingo had not submitted all the required paperwork to support a request for a waiver of prepayment of fees and costs.

IT IS ORDERED that the court's May 13, 2022 dismissal order is vacated as having been issued prematurely; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this matter will be subject to dismissal under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83 unless, within 30 days of the date of this order, the \$195.00 filing fee is received by the Clerk's office, or Mr. Kudingo shows good cause for a waiver of prepayment of fees and
