Dye v. DeVries L.C.#2022IP13

By order dated June 23, 2022, this court construed the letter filed June 17, 2022, by petitioner John L. Dye, Jr., pro se, to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. On July 18, 2022, the court of appeals issued an order reinstating the writ action filed in that court. Because the writ proceeding has been reinstated, this court will dismiss the pending petition for review, as there is now no final decision of the court of appeals in this matter that is adverse to Mr. Dye. If the court of appeals' final decision on the pending writ proceeding in that court is ultimately adverse to Mr. Dye, he may file a petition for review in this court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' final decision. IT IS ORDERED that the petition for review filed June 17, 2022, is dismissed.
