On August 1, 2022, petitioner, Jason Hempstead, pro se, filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus alleging, among other things, that he is currently being held in a Colorado correctional facility on a Wisconsin felony charge. The Wisconsin case in question is State v. Hempstead, Marathon County Circuit Court Case No. 2020CF988. The court has reviewed the circuit court's record, which shows that the petitioner, Jason Hempstead, has not been convicted in the above referenced Wisconsin circuit court case and that there is currently still an active warrant for his arrest in the State of Wisconsin for this case. In addition, the court has also reviewed the Colorado Department of Corrections Offender Search website which shows that the petitioner is serving out sentences in the Colorado correctional facility for Colorado case numbers 20CR366, 20CR2620, and 20CR367;

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for writ of habeas corpus is dismissed. This court does not have jurisdiction to provide relief for cases arising out of any other state court.
