On June 23, 2022, the clerk of this court received a pro se letter from defendant-appellant, Jeremy T. Greene. Attached to the letter was a cover page bearing the case caption and case number for this matter that was entitled "The Petition for Review." The letter asked the clerk to file this attached petition for review. The letter also asked the clerk to file an enclosed "Motion to Permit Remainder of a Conforming Petition to Be Filed," although no such motion was enclosed. The court will deem the letter and attached cover page to be a nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of February 17, 2022, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated May 16, 2022. The petition, however, must be dismissed because it is untimely pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 808.10 and 809.62(1m), and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). It was not filed within the 30-

day period following the date of the court of appeals' decision of February 17, 2022. Moreover, the 30-day deadline was not tolled under Wis. Stat. § 808.10(2) because the motion for reconsideration was not filed within 20 days after the date of the court of appeals' decision. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for review is dismissed, without costs. No action will be taken regarding the June 23, 2022 letter's reference to a "Motion to permit Remainder of a Conforming Petition to be Filed" because no such motion was submitted and the petition is being dismissed as untimely.
