On March 24, 2022, petitioner, Thomas Edward Ulve, pro se, filed a document entitled "Petition for Habeas Corpus Relief" with this court. On that same date, the clerk of this court opened case file number 2022AP472-W, State ex rel. Ulve v. Carr. The clerk then mailed a notice to the petitioner acknowledging the filing of a petition for a writ of habeas corpus.

Although the document filed on March 24, 2022, is entitled "Petition for Habeas Corpus Relief," the document asks this court to appoint counsel for the petitioner so the court construes the document to be a motion to appoint counsel in a pending circuit court case, State v. Ulve, Green County Case No. 2020CF97. Accordingly, Supreme Court Case No. 2022AP472-W, State ex rel. Ulve v. Carr, was opened in error. In order to correct this error, Case No. 2022AP472-W will be dismissed, and that case file will be closed. Petitioner's motion to appoint counsel filed on March 24, 2022, will be considered under Case No. 2022XX565, Ulve v. Carr. The court notes that Mr. Ulve filed another motion to appoint counsel on April 8, 2022, which will also be considered under Case No. 2022XX565.

Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 2022AP472-W is hereby dismissed. Petitioner's "Petition for Habeas Corpus Relief" shall be considered under Case No. 2022XX565, Ulve v. Carr, and is construed to be a motion to appoint counsel; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motions filed March 24, 2022, and April 8, 2022, by petitioner, Thomas Edward Ulve, pro se, for the appointment of counsel are denied. This court will not appoint counsel for a case pending in a circuit court. If Mr. Ulve believes he is entitled to the appointment of counsel, he may contact the Office of the State Public Defender directly.
