The court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter on July 19, 2022. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 must be filed in this court pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.80 within 30 days of the court of appeals' adverse decision. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter was August 18, 2022. Wis. Stat. § 808.10(1). At 5:06 p.m., on August 18, 2022, counsel for respondent-appellant, L.T.H., sent, via facsimile transmission, a copy of the petition for review along with a motion for

an enlargement of time to file the required numbers of paper copies of the petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.62.

Petitions for review: (1) must comply with Wis. Stat. §§ (Rules) 809.62(1) and 809.81, (2) must be accompanied by the required \$195 filing fee, unless waived, and (3) must be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision unless a timely motion for reconsideration is filed in the court of appeals. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Because petitions for review require a filing fee, they may not be filed by facsimile. Wis. Stat. § 801.16(2).

In this case, no paper original of a petition for review was filed by August 18, 2021. Consequently, no petition for review has been timely filed in this matter, and the defendant-appellant has not invoked this court's appellate jurisdiction. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this court shall reject the copy of the petition for review that was sent via facsimile.
