On August 23, 2022, the respondent-appellant, T.K., pro se, submitted via facsimile transmission a petition for review seeking review of a July 26, 2022 decision of the court of appeals.

A petition for review (1) must comply with Wis. Stat. §§ (Rules) 809.62(1) and 809.81, (2) must be accompanied by the required \$195 filing fee or a completed petition for waiver of the filing fee, and (3) must be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision unless a timely motion for reconsideration is filed in the court of appeals. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Consequently, a petition for review may not be filed via facsimile transmission. Accordingly,
