IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 809.32(4) and 809.62, S.R. may file a supplemental petition with the clerk of this court by September 30, 2022. The supplemental petition shall state reasons in support of the review and satisfy the requirements of § 809.62(2)(a), (b), (c), and (e). If no supplemental petition is filed within the prescribed time, this matter will be submitted to the court for appropriate action; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner-respondent, State of Wisconsin, shall file its response to the no-merit petition for review and any supplemental petition on or before October 14, 2022.
