The court having considered the pro se letter and document entitled "Motion to Appeal" that were filed by petitioner Ambrose McDaniel, on September 21, 2022, and the court noting that Mr. McDaniel previously filed premature pro se motions, which this court dismissed by order dated May 6, 2022;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion and all accompanying requests for relief are dismissed. There is still no matter pending before this court involving Mr. McDaniel in which this court's jurisdiction has been properly invoked. Mr. McDaniel's current motion and letter reference State v. McDaniel, Milwaukee County Case No. 2022CF226. According to the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) website, that case remains open and pending before the Milwaukee County Circuit Court. No final judgment has been entered in that case that could permit an appeal as of right. In such situations, requests for relief should ordinarily be filed in the trial court.
