No. 2020AP842-CRNM State v. Brown, L.C. #2017CF112

A petition for review was filed by defendant-appellant, Leslie A. Brown, pro se, on October 3, 2022, from the court of appeals' August 16, 2022 decision. Attached to the petition for review is a "Certification of Mailing," which states that Mr. Brown placed the petition into the prison mail on September 17, 2022. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review from the August 16, 2022 court of appeals decision, however, expired on September 15, 2022. Although the time period for filing a petition for review is tolled when an incarcerated person places the petition into the prison mail system, in this case the period had already expired. Consequently, the petition is untimely pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10 and 809.62(1m), and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d. 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979), and must be dismissed. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for review is dismissed, without costs.
