On September 30, 2022, defendant-appellant-petitioner, Daimon Von Jackson, filed a motion to supplement the record with two documents from State v. Jackson, Racine County Circuit Court Case No. 2014CF1721: (1) Record Item No. 41—an October 19, 2016 letter from Mr. Jackson to the circuit court; and (2) Record Item No. 44—an October 28, 2016 pro se motion to terminate counsel. On October 4, 2022, plaintiff-respondent, State of Wisconsin, filed a response to this motion. The State objects to the motion and asks the court to strike any references to these documents from Mr. Von Jackson's initial brief, which was filed on the same day as the motion and which cites to the documents at issue—documents the State represents it has not seen.
