Shellow v. Forester-Hoare, L.C. #2021PR35

The court having construed the document titled "Motion to Intervene," dated September 30, 2022, and filed on October 5, 2022, by respondent, James Shellow, pro se, as a petition for review of the court of appeals' June 17, 2022 order. The petition is untimely pursuant to §§ 808.10 and 809.62(1m), Stats., and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Although the time period for filing a petition for review is tolled when an incarcerated person places the petition into the prison mail system, in this case the filing indicates that the period had already expired by the time Mr. Shellow placed his document in the prison mail system. See State ex rel. Nichols v. Litscher, 2001 WI 119, 247 Wis. 2d 1013, 635 N.W.2d 292;
