On October 10, 2022, counsel for respondent-appellant-petitioner, L.N.H., filed a no-merit petition for review of the court of appeals' September 13, 2022 decision. In termination of parental rights cases (TPR) only one copy of the petition for review must be physically filed with a petitioner's original signature. This copy is placed in the court's confidential file. Ten copies with the signature redacted to only show the petitioner's initials must then be filed in this court along with one electronic version.
