Tran v. Hepp, L.C. #2015CF4012

The court having considered the motion of petitioner, Tony Tran, pro se, to deem the motion itself as a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of September 21, 2022, and the court noting that in the motion Mr. Tran indicated that he would supplement the nonconforming petition for review with a statement conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) within 60 days; and the court further noting that with the motion Mr. Tran filed the incorrect "Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs Affidavit of Indigency" form;

IT IS ORDERED the motion is granted. The motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by December 20, 2022. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner, Tony Tran, shall have until October 28, 2022 to either pay the filing fee or submit the correct prisoner's petition for waiver of fees/costs-affidavit of indigency as well as a certified copy of his prisoner's trust fund account for the last six months.
