Gahl v. Aurora Health Care, Inc., L.C. #2021CV1469

The court having considered the motions filed by petitioner-respondent-petitioner, Allen Gahl, to: (1) extend the time in which to file his opening brief; (2) to waive the requirement of Wis. Stat. § 809.19(2)(ae) to allow him to e-file his 540 page appendix in five sections due to the size of the electronic files; and (3) to reduce from 22 to 11 the required number of copies of the appendix that must be physically filed;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion to waive the requirement of Wis. Stat § 809.19(2)(ae), which provides that, “The appendix shall be filed as a single document” is denied. Petitioner-respondent-petitioner is encouraged to attempt to reduce the size of the appendix so that it can be

filed as a single document. In addition, petitioner-respondent-petitioner is directed to the 2021 Comment to § 809.19, which states, “In the event of a very large appendix that cannot be electronically filed as a single document due to the size limitations of the system, s. 809.801(8) directs the user to contact the clerk of court for assistance.” Petitioner-respondent-petitioner is instructed to contact the e-filing support line at (800) 462-8843 for assistance in filing the appendix as a single document. If, after due diligence, petitioner-respondent-petitioner is still unable to file the appendix as a single document, he may renew his motion to file a multi-volume appendix but shall inform the court of the efforts he has taken to comply with the requirements of § 809.19(2)ae); and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to reduce from 22 to 11 the required number of copies of the appendix that must be physically filed is denied; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time to file petitioner-respondent-petitioner’s opening brief is granted. Petitioner-respondent-petitioner shall have until November 2, 2022 to properly file his opening brief and appendix.
