Ryan P. McKeown, pro se, having filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus related to an ongoing circuit court matter, State v. McKeown, Sheboygan County Circuit Court Case No. 2020CF646;

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is dismissed. Habeas relief is unavailable when there is an adequate alternative remedy available in the law. State ex rel. Haas v. McReynolds, 2002 WI 43, ¶12, 252 Wis. 2d 133, 643 N.W.2d 771. Mr. McKeown necessarily cannot demonstrate that there are no adequate alternative remedies available in the law given that, according to Wisconsin Circuit Court Access records, post-conviction proceedings in Case No. 2020CF646 are ongoing; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other requests for relief made by Mr. McKeown are denied as moot.
