On October 12, 2022 the court construed the document titled "Motion to Intervene," dated September 30, 2022, and received on October 5, 2022, by appellant, Sean Forester-Hoare, pro se, as a petition for review of the court of appeals' June 17, 2022 order. The document also asked, amongst other things, for this court to intervene in Racine County Case No. 2011CF436. Due to the illegibility of most of the document the court improperly named James Shellow as the petitioning party when in fact the petitioning party was Sean L. Forester-Hoare. In its October 12, 2022 order, this court dismissed the petition as untimely pursuant to §§ 808.10 and 809.62(1m), Stats., and First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). However, on October 12, 2022, the court of appeals issued an order denying Mr. Forester-Hoare's August 17, 2022 motion asking the court of appeals to reconsider their June 17, 2022 order. Since petitions for review must be physically filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a motion for reconsideration, see Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80, in this

instance the 30-day deadline to file a petition for review is November 11, 2022. Thus, the document received on October 5, 2022 may be construed as a timely, but nonconforming, petition for review. Accordingly;

IT IS ORDERED that this court's order of October 12, 2022 is vacated; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the "Motion to Intervene" received on October 5, 2022, shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' order of June 17, 2022. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by November 25, 2022. When drafting the statement in support of the petition for review appellant, Mr. Forester-Hoare, is directed to either type it, or write it using a dark ink so that it is legible. If the statement is not filed by that time this petition will be summarily dismissed; and.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court will take no action on the request to intervene in Racine County Case No. 2011CF436. A petition for review in that case was denied on September 25, 2014.
