You are hereby notified that the Court has entered the following order:

No. 2020AP2166-D OLR v. Matthew T. Luening

On October 24, 2022, this court directed the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) to explain why the complaint filed in this matter did not cite the applicable rules set forth in 8 C.F.R. § 1003.102, as did the complaint in OLR v. Din, No. 2020AP2165-D, and why SCR 20:8.5(b) does not require the counts of misconduct arising out of Attorney Luening's immigration practice to be governed by Executive Office of Immigration Review (EOIR) rules of conduct. The OLR filed its response on November 3, 2022.

IT IS ORDERED that on or before November 18, 2022, Attorney Matthew T. Luening shall file a reply to the OLR's response. The response shall address, inter alia, whether Attorney Luening waived application of the EOIR rules by not affirmatively raising the issue.
