You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2022XX484-CR State v. Ambrose McDaniel, L.C. #2022CF226

The court having considered the pro se letter that was filed by petitioner Ambrose McDaniel, on November 8, 2022, and the court noting that Mr. McDaniel previously filed premature pro se motions, which this court dismissed by orders dated May 6, 2022 and October 5, 2022;

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the letter filed on November 8, 2022. This court's appellate jurisdiction is invoked by a properly filed petition for review following a final decision issued by the court of appeals in an appeal. There is still no matter pending before this court involving Mr. McDaniel in which this court's jurisdiction has been properly invoked. Mr. McDaniel's current motion and letter reference State v. McDaniel, Milwaukee County Case No. 2022CF226. According to the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) website, a notice of intent to pursue postconviction relief has been filed in that case in the Milwaukee County Circuit Court, and the notice of intent, the court record sheet, and a copy of the judgment of conviction have been forwarded to the Office of the State Public Defender for
