The court having construed the document dated on November 17, 2022, and filed on November 21, 2022, by defendant-appellant, Jamell A. Sanford, pro se, as a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of September 27, 2022;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because it was not filed within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stats. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Although Mr. Sanford filed a motion for reconsideration in the court of appeals, he did not do so timely (i.e., within 20 days of the original September 27, 2022 decision in that court). Therefore, the deadline for filing the petition for review in the supreme court was not tolled under Wis. Stat. § 808.10(2) and expired
