In the Amended Petition for Reinstatement of Attorney Tim Osicka
Case nos. 2012AP60-D & 2013AP434-D

Pending before the court is Attorney Tim Osicka's amended petition for reinstatement of his license to practice law in Wisconsin. On November 16, 2022, Attorney Osicka filed a motion to expedite his amended petition. On November 18, 2022, this court ordered the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) and Tim Osicka to confer and inform this court, in writing, whether they have been able to come to an agreement on either a waiver of costs and restitution or a payment plan for costs and restitution. The court also ordered the OLR to inform the court whether it has any objection to Attorney Osicka's amended petition. While the court reviews the amended petition and waits for the responses from the parties, the court notes that in order for Attorney Osicka to be reinstated he must satisfy bar dues, assessments, and fees or seek a waiver from the State Bar of Wisconsin.

By email dated November 22, 2022, the State Bar of Wisconsin has informed the court that in order for Attorney Tim Osicka to reinstate to active status, Attorney Osicka owes \$1003.00 in bar dues, assessments, and fees. Therefore, the court wishes to inform Attorney Osicka that before

his law license may be reinstated he must pay the \$1003.00 in bar dues, assessments, and fees or seek a waiver from the State Bar of Wisconsin.
