No. 2021AP186-CRNM State v. Nelis, L.C.#2018CF185

The court having construed the "Petition for Review" filed November 30, 2022, by defendant-appellant, Brian M. Nelis, pro se, to be a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of October 25, 2022;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by

January 3, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the statement in support of the petition must be signed by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Brian M. Nelis. Failure to comply with this directive may result in the dismissal of the petition for review. See Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83. The court notes that the "Petition for Review" filed November 30, 2022 appears to be signed by someone other than Mr. Nelis.
