You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2022AP2102-W Smith v. Ball, L.C. #s 2022CF3626 & 2022CF1326

On December 7, 2022, petitioner, Bruce E. Smith, pro se, filed a document in this court. The court construes the document to be a petition for writ of habeas corpus. No case number was provided on the petition. A search on the Consolidated Court Automation Program (CCAP) of Mr. Smith was performed and two pending Milwaukee County Circuit Court cases were identified (2022CF3626 and 2022CF1326). The court notes that Mr. Smith is represented by counsel in the two above referenced cases. Given this procedural posture;

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for writ of habeas corpus is dismissed. Habeas relief is unavailable when there is an adequate alternative remedy available in the law. State ex rel. Haas v. McReynolds, 2002 WI 43, ¶12, 252 Wis. 2d 133, 643 N.W.2d 771.
