The court having considered the letter of defendant-appellant, Bradley J. Young, filed on December 5, 2022, indicating that defendant-appellant wishes to petition for review of the court of appeals' opinion of October 19, 2022, and stating that he had not yet received a copy of the court of appeal's decision, and the court noting that it appears mailing errors prevented Mr. Young from receiving a copy of the court of appeals' October 19, 2022 decision within the 30-day period for filing a petition for review;

IT IS ORDERED that the letter filed by defendant-appellant on December 5, 2022 shall be construed as a petition for a writ of habeas corpus. See State ex rel. Fuentes v. Wisconsin Court of Appeals, 225 Wis. 2d 446, 593 N.W.2d 48 (1999); and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the petition for a writ of habeas corpus is granted, ex parte. Defendant-appellant may file a petition for review in Case No. 2021AP1316-CR, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), with the clerk of this court by January 26, 2023.
