IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979); and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but non-conforming petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by February 6, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time the petition will be dismissed.
