On December 19, 2022, DeJuan Anthony Mason filed a document titled, "High Prerogative Writ of Quo Warranto." Despite this title, upon review, the court hereby construes the filing as a petition for supervisory writ. The court construes the filing as such because the filing does not appear to challenge a particular person's right to hold office, which is the proper subject of a petition for quo warranto. Rather, the filing appears to challenge the jurisdiction of the Milwaukee County Circuit Court in Milwaukee County Case Number 2019PA116PJ, which is more appropriately the subject of a petition for supervisory writ. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Mr. Mason's filing shall be construed as a petition for supervisory writ challenging the jurisdiction of the Milwaukee County Circuit Court in Milwaukee County Case Number 2019PA116PJ; and
