Chestnut v. Circuit Court for Milwaukee County  
L.C.#s 2015CF2584 and 2021CF588

On December 29, 2022, counsel for petitioner Haneef Hasan Chestnut filed a "Petition for . . . Writ of Prohibition or Supervisory Writ" and a "Motion to Exceed 35-Page Limit and to Accept Petition Filed Herewith as Properly Filed." The court notes that the petition and motion, which lack handwritten signatures, are not properly signed. See "In re Interim Court Rule Governing Electronic Filing in the Supreme Court," S. Ct. Order 19-02A and 20-07A, 2021 WI 62 (issued June 15, 2021, eff. July 1, 2021), Revised Interim Rule at 6 ("Handwritten signatures must be used to sign paper documents. See former § 802.05(1)."). The petition also lacks the required certification of compliance with Wis. Stat. §§ 809.51(1) and 809.51(4), setting forth the word count (if a proportional serif font is used) or the page count (if a monospaced font is used). Note that the page-count option is not available if a proportional serif font is used.

IT IS ORDERED that the "Petition for . . . Writ of Prohibition or Supervisory Writ" is dismissed without prejudice as improperly filed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the "Motion to Exceed 35-Page Limit and to Accept Petition Filed Herewith as Properly Filed" is dismissed as moot.
