On September 30, 2019, defendant-appellant, Sean T. Pugh, pro se, filed a petition for review regarding the court of appeals' decision of August 6, 2019, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order of August 29, 2019. In a letter accompanying the petition for review, Mr. Pugh notes that he placed the petition in the prison mail system on September 26, 2019. In this same letter, Mr. Pugh asks the court to hold his petition for review in abeyance as he is "soliciting counsel to take [his] case." He alternatively asks the court to grant him a 45-day extension to file an "amended" petition for review, "as this submission is not quite complete."

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted in part. Mr. Pugh shall have until November 4, 2019, to file a supplement to his petition for review already on file. If the supplement is not

filed by that time, this petition will be decided upon the current filings. No further time extensions will be granted. Mr. Pugh is reminded that this court, by order dated September 11, 2019, has required the Mr. Pugh's petition for review shall not exceed 11,000 words. Consistent with this requirement, the petition for review on file and any supplement Mr. Pugh elects to file must, combined, total no more than 11,000 words.
