On September 9, 2019, defendant-appellant, Sean T. Pugh, pro se, filed a letter asking this court to allow him to proceed as indigent and to exceed the 8,000 word limit for petitions for review, as prescribed in Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(4)(a), by 6,000 words, for a total of 14,000 words.

Mr. Pugh's request to exceed the governing word limit will be construed as a motion for same.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted in part. Mr. Pugh may file a petition for review that shall not exceed 11,000 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any petition for review will be subject to dismissal under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83 unless, upon filing the petition, Mr. Pugh either pays the \$195.00 filing fee or shows good cause for waiving the prepayment of the filing fee by filing the Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency that is being sent to Mr. Pugh with his copy of this order. Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1)(b). If Mr. Pugh accompanies his petition for review with a completed Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency, the court will determine whether Mr. Pugh is entitled to file his petition for review without the prepayment of the filing fee.
