No. 2018AP1335-W Braithwaite v. Boughton, L.C. #2012CF867

The court having construed the document (dated January 15, 2023) filed on January 19, 2023, by petitioner, Joshua P. Braithwaite, pro se, as a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' decision of November 15, 2022;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because it was not filed within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision or within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stats. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Accordingly, this court has no jurisdiction in this matter. See Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360.
