State v. Dixon L.C.#s 2020CF2595 & 2020CF2688

The court has construed the document entitled "Direct Review," filed on January 9, 2023, by defendant, Anthony Donte Dixon, pro se, to be a motion asking this court to immediately review the judgments of conviction in Milwaukee County Case Nos. 2020CF2595 and 2020CF2688. There is currently no appellate proceeding regarding those cases in either this court or the court of appeals in which the defendant's motion could be considered. Moreover, this court notes that the defendant was represented by counsel in the circuit court and that the court of appeals issued an order on January 20, 2023, that allows the State Public Defender's office to retroactively appoint counsel for Mr. Dixon in postconviction proceedings or an appeal. If the defendant ultimately files an appeal and the court of appeals' final decision in that appeal is adverse to Mr. Dixon, he will be entitled to file a petition for review in this court at that time. Because there is no current proceeding
