Catholic Charities Bureau, Inc. v. Wisconsin Labor and Industry
Review Commission, L.C. #2019CV324

On January 12, 2023, petitioners-respondents-petitioners, Catholic Charities Bureau, Barron County Developmental Services, Inc., Diversified Services, Inc., Black River Industries, Inc., and Headwaters, Inc., filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' December 13, 2022 decision. On January 26, 2023, respondent-appellant, State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development, filed a response to the petition for review. Also on January 26, 2023, respondent-co-appellant, State of Wisconsin Labor and Industry Review Commission, filed a letter joining in the positions of the response to the petition for review. The court has also received the following filings in this case:

1. Motion of non-party Wisconsin Catholic Conference for leave to file a brief *amicus curiae* in support of Petitioners, and proposed brief;

2. Motion of non-parties Catholic Conferences of Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, and Minnesota for leave to file a brief *amici curiae* in support of Petitioners, and proposed brief;
3. Two motions filed by resident counsel, Attorney Robert S. Driscoll, on behalf of non-parties Catholic Conferences of Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, and Minnesota for admission of non-resident counsel, Attorneys Tiernan B. Kane and Stephen M. Judge of South Bank Legal, *pro hac vice*;
4. Motion of non-parties Maranatha Baptist University, Maranatha Baptist Academy, Concordia University Wisconsin, The Wisconsin Family Counsel, and the Wisconsin Association of Christian Schools for leave to file a brief *amici curiae* in support of Petitioners, and proposed brief, as well a motion asking the court to grant them 10 minutes of supplemental oral argument time.

IT IS ORDERED that all motions submitted for leave to file non-party briefs *amici curiae* are granted;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all motions for admission for non-resident attorneys, *pro hac vice*, are granted. A copy of SCR 10.03(4), setting forth the requirements for attorneys appearing *pro hac vice*, is attached to the moving party's and the non-resident attorneys' orders;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that only the Wisconsin Catholic Conference's *amicus* brief submitted with the accompanying motion is accepted as filed;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the briefs submitted by Catholic Conferences of Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, and Minnesota, and Maranatha Baptist University, Maranatha Baptist Academy, Concordia University Wisconsin, The Wisconsin Family Counsel, and the Wisconsin Association of Christian Schools are rejected due to formatting defects, the nature of which shall be explained in a separate communication from the clerk of this court. The *amici* parties shall have until February 15, 2023, to file corrected briefs;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for supplemental oral argument time is denied as premature. This court has not yet rendered a decision on the petition for review.
