Kindschy v. Aish, L.C. #2020CV40

The court is aware that on January 13, 2023, the United States Supreme Court granted a petition for certiorari in Counterman v. Colorado, U.S. Case No. 22-138. The petition in that case raised the following issue:

Whether, to establish that a statement is a "true threat" unprotected by the First Amendment, the government must show that the speaker subjectively knew or intended the threatening nature of the statement, or whether it is enough to show that an objective "reasonable person" would regard the statement as a threat of violence.

The court notes that a decision in Counterman may affect the resolution of the legal issues in the above-captioned matter. Accordingly,
