On February 7, 2023, counsel for respondent-appellant-petitioner, T.R., filed a petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 808.10. The petition and the appendix fail to observe the confidentiality rules applicable to termination of parental rights cases, in two respects: (1) in all copies of the petition for review, T.R.'s signature appears in full; i.e., in unredacted form; and (2) in the appendix, the parents' and child's names are only partially redacted; i.e., the text underneath the redactions is still readable. Cf. Wis. Stat. § 809.19(1)(g), 2(am).

IT IS ORDERED that counsel for T.R. shall, by two weeks from the date of this order:

- file one copy of the petition for review with T.R.'s full, unredacted signature, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted; i.e.,

redacted to show only the initials of the parents and child, in such a manner that the text underneath the redactions cannot be read. This copy will be placed in the court's confidential file;

- file nine additional copies of the petition for review with T.R.'s signature properly redacted, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted;
- file an electronic version of the petition for review with T.R.'s signature properly redacted. An electronic copy of the appendix is not required; and
- serve on opposing counsel one copy of the petition for review with T.R.'s signature properly redacted, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted.
