**FINDINGS**

The Respondent, Pablo Galaviz, failed to file an answer to OLR's disciplinary complaint in this matter. He was personally served with a copy of the complaint and the order to answer.

In the scheduling order dated October 4, 2022, a telephonic scheduling conference was set for October 20, 2022. Respondent failed to appear.


In the scheduling order dated October 25, 2022, the Respondent was ordered to file an answer to the complaint and appear at the rescheduled conference of November 30, 2022. Respondent was advised that I would consider a motion for default judgment if he failed to appear in this matter at the rescheduled conference. The Respondent again failed to file an answer or appear at the rescheduled conference.

On January 31, 2023, OLR filed a Motion for Default Judgment in this matter.

A Declaration of Default (Referee will recommend that the Wisconsin Supreme Court grant Default Judgment to OLR) is granted to the Office of Lawyer Regulation. Referee's Report and Recommendation will follow.
