Vega v. DeHaan L.C. #1993CF934212

On February 22, 2023, the court issued an order that deemed an extension motion filed by the petitioner, Alfredo Vega, pro se, to be a timely but nonconforming petition to review the court of appeals' decision of January 20, 2023, and directed the petitioner to file a statement in support of the petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) by March 29, 2023. On March 8, 2023, the petitioner filed a document entitled "Notice of Appeal," which did not contain the elements required in a petition for review under Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). A request for review in the supreme court is initiated by filing a petition for review, not a "Notice of Appeal." See Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10 and 809.62. The court has already treated the petitioner's February 17, 2023 filing as a petition for review. Thus, the only thing that the petitioner needs to complete is a statement in support of his petition for review that complies with the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). A copy of those statutory provisions is attached to the petitioner's copy of this order. In light of the petitioner's apparent confusion over what he is required to do to complete his petition for review, the deadline for him to submit his statement in support will be extended. The failure to submit a complying statement in support by the deadline, however, will result in the dismissal of the petition for review. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the "Notice of Appeal" filed by the petitioner on March 8, 2023. The petitioner must still file a statement in support of the petition for review that conforms to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4); and

IT IS ORDERED that the deadline for the petitioner to file the statement in support of the petition for review is extended until April 12, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted.
