On February 21, 2023, the defendant-appellant, Doug S. Nitek, pro se, filed a motion to extend the time in which to file a "statement in support of his petition to review." On February 23, 2023, this court denied defendant-appellant's motion but deemed the motion to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. The court also ordered the petition for review be held in abeyance pending action by the court of appeals on defendant-appellant's simultaneous motion for reconsideration. On March 9, 2023, the court of appeals denied the defendant-appellant's motion for reconsideration. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed by the defendant-appellant with the clerk of this

court by May 15, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff-respondent's, State of Wisconsin, response to the petition for review shall be filed within 14 days after service of the defendant-appellant's statement in support.
