On March 16, 2023, defendant-appellant, John Russell Kanerva, pro se, filed a document in this court. The court deems this filing to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' February 14, 2023 order. Also on March 16, 2023, Mr. Kanerva, filed a petition for waiver of the filing fee for the petition for review, but the waiver petition is incomplete because it was not notarized. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the document filed by the defendant-appellant on March 16, 2023, shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by April 21, 2023, defendant-appellant, John Russell Kanerva, must either pay the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for waiving the fee by filing a complete and notarized petition for waiver of fees;<sup>1</sup> and,
