The court having construed the letter filed on March 27, 2023, by defendant-appellant-petitioner, Curtis James Rumsey, pro se, as motions for: (1) the waiver of the required number of copies of the petition for review; (2) an extension of time to file indigency documents; and (3) the court, through its clerk, to serve a copy of the petition for review and appendix on opposing counsel; and the court noting that defendant-appellant-petitioner already filed one copy of his petition for review and appendix with the clerk of this court on March 27, 2023, with the letter containing the motions identified above;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for waiver of the required number of copies is granted. The petition for review and appendix are accepted for filing as of March 27, 2023; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time to file indigency documents is granted. The petition for review will be subject to dismissal under Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.83 unless, within 30 days of the date of this order, defendant-appellant-petitioner pays the \$195.00 filing fee or shows good cause for waiving the payment of the filing fee by completing and filing the Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency that was sent to defendant-appellant-petitioner on March 27, 2023, by the clerk of this court; and,
