ORDER REGARDING HEARING

A conference was held by telephone in this proceeding on February 10, 2023 on the parties' Second Partial Stipulation narrowing the issues in this proceeding, and the effect of the stipulation on the conduct of the proceeding. The participants in the telephone conference were Attorney John T. Payette for Complainant, Attorney Stacie H. Rosenzweig for Respondent, and the Referee.

Prior to the conference, counsel for the parties advised me that they were agreeable to adjourning the hearing until a date in the summer of 2023. Counsel subsequently advised me that they had agreed to a hearing date and location. On March 1, 2023, the Second Partial Stipulation was filed with the Court. Therefore, by agreement of the parties and for cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The hearing on the merits will commence July 20, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. at the Milwaukee Bar Association, 747 North Broadway, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. If a second day of hearing is required, it will occur on July 21, 2023 at 9:00 at the same location.

2. The issues at the hearing will be the contested issues identified in the Second Partial Stipulation filed in this proceeding March 1, 2023.

3. Any motion *in limine* will be served and filed in such time as to permit the opposing party a reasonable opportunity to serve and file a response, and the Referee a reasonable opportunity to consider and rule on same in advance of the hearing.
