Anthony T. Kudingo v. Calvin Barrett, L.C. #2009CF498

On October 3, 2022, Antony T. Kudingo filed a pro se document that, on its cover page, is labeled a "Petition for Review." Mr. Kudingo filed this petition after receiving a September 13, 2022 order from this court that denied his petition for writ of habeas corpus and various accompanying motions.

Also on October 3, 2022, this court issued a document that "acknowledge[d] receipt of the Petition for Review which has been filed in the above matter pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 808.10 and 809.62." However, the relief requested by Mr. Kudingo in his October 3, 2022 filing appears to be more appropriately the subject of a motion for reconsideration of this court's September 13, 2022 order. Mr. Kudingo's filing cannot be construed as a petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 808.10 and 809.62, as such a petition must concern a decision of the court of appeals—not an order of this court. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10(1).
