ORDER FOLLOWING SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

**CLERK OF SUPREME COURT
OF WISCONSIN**

On March 2, 2022, at approximately 10:00 a.m., a Zoom scheduling conference was held in this matter pursuant to SCR 22.13. The Office of Lawyer Regulation appeared by Attorney John T. Payette. The Respondent, Brian T. Stevens, appeared in person and was represented by Attorney Stacie H. Rosenzweig. Based upon the statements, discussions and agreements that occurred during the telephonic scheduling conference,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- (1) The hearing in this matter will commence on October 12, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. If necessary, it will continue on October 13, 2022. Absent an objection from one of the parties, the hearing will be conducted at the law offices of Attorney Robert J. Janssen, 3000 Riverside Dr., #210, Green Bay, WI. OLR shall select a court reporter from the State-approved list and Attorney Rosenzweig reserves the right to object. OLR will notify me of the name of the chosen reporter and I will enter an appointment Order.
- (2) Both parties will submit a Preliminary Witness List no later than May 11, 2022.
- (3) The Discovery deadline for both parties is August 8, 2022.
- (4) A Final Pre-Trial Conference will be conducted by Zoom on September 28, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. The Respondent must participate personally in that conference. OLR shall make arrangements for the Zoom call.
- (5) All of the following must be completed prior to the September 28, 2022 Final Pre-Trial Conference:
 - (a) Motions in Limine must be filed by both parties .
 - (b) Both parties must file with the Referee a complete marked copy of all Exhibits to be used at the hearing. OLR's Exhibits shall be marked beginning with Exhibit 1. Respondent's Exhibits shall be marked beginning with Exhibit 500. Each party shall place their Exhibits in

- a 3-ring binder in chronological order and supply both the Referee and opposing counsel with a binder containing copies of all Exhibits. In the alternative, the parties may agree upon a joint Exhibit presentation which shall be marked and placed in a binder.
- (c) Trial briefs are optional, but if a party chooses to file one, it must be on or before September 28, 2022.
 - (d) Final witness lists must be filed by both parties.
- (6) All future correspondence and pleadings by the parties shall be filed by providing the Clerk of the Wisconsin Supreme Court with the originals, with copies provided to the referee and opposing counsel both by email and U.S. Mail.
 - (7) The parties have agreed the Referee will communicate with them by email and will not provide them copies by U.S. Mail. The Referee will file original documents she prepares with the Clerk and will also maintain a "Working File" consisting of emails, notes and copies of documents she creates in the course of this proceeding. Said working file will be filed with the Clerk prior to or simultaneously with the filing of the Referee's Report and Recommendation.
 - (8) Zoom conferences or telephonic conferences will not be recorded unless a written request is made by a party.
 - (9) The parties are reminded that the Referee will make a recommendation based upon the record and she will not be aware of prior discipline, other pending matters, or other evidence unless presented as part of the case.
 - (10) The parties should be prepared to verbally highlight during the hearing the relevant portions of lengthy exhibits or depositions they wish to bring to the attention of the Referee.
 - (11) If at any time during the course of this case the Respondent is not represented by legal counsel, he shall supply any and all email addresses he uses and all telephone numbers at which he can be reached. He shall also comply with all provisions of this Scheduling Order.
