On April 14, 2023, this court received and liberally construed a document filed by petitioner, Karl Julius James, pro se, as a petition for writ of habeas corpus and issued its standard Acknowledgement of Filing of Writ/Petition form. It also ordered Mr. James to pay the \$195.00 filing fee or file the proper indigency forms that were forwarded with the order. On April 24, 2023, after receiving the above referenced documents, Mr. James filed another document with this court indicating that the above referenced writ case was opened in error and that he actually wanted to pursue a violation of civil rights action against the Green Bay Correctional Institution for, amongst other things, failing to provide him medical treatment as well as returning his legal mail to the courts with no return address. This court notes that it is not the proper venue to file a violation of civil rights action. Accordingly;

IT IS ORDERED that by May 26, 2023, Karl Julius James, shall file with this court a letter indicating if he would like to pursue habeas relief. If Mr. James answers in the affirmative he will also need to file the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for waiving the fee by filing the proper indigency forms that were sent to him by the clerk's office on April 14, 2023. If Mr. James indicates he does not want to pursue habeas relief, the above referenced writ case shall be dismissed and no other action will be taken on the documents filed on April 14, 2023 and April 24, 2023.
