State v. Kanerva, L.C.#22FO357

On March 16, 2023, defendant-appellant, John Russell Kanerva, pro se, filed a document in this court. By order dated March 22, 2023, this court deemed the filing to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' February 14, 2023 order. By the court's same order, Mr. Kanerva was directed to file, no later than April 21, 2023, a statement in support of the nonconforming petition for review that conforms to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). Mr. Kanerva was also directed to either pay the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for waiving the fee by filing a complete and notarized petition for waiver of fees. A copy of the incomplete waiver petition previously filed by Mr. Kanerva was attached to Mr. Kanerva's copy of the March 22, 2023 order.

On April 21, 2023, Mr. Kanerva filed a document entitled "Quo Warranto/Writ of Certiorari . . . ." This court construes this filing to be Mr. Kanerva's statement in support of the nonconforming petition for review. In the document, Mr. Kanerva claims that he "qualifies for waiver of filing fees." However, Mr. Kanerva still has not filed a complete and notarized petition for waiver of fees.
