The court having construed the document filed on April 26, 2023, by respondent-appellant, G.M.I., pro se, to be a timely nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals April 4, 2023 decision; and the court noting that G.M.I.'s nonconforming petition for review fails to observe the confidentiality rules applicable to termination of parental rights cases;<sup>1</sup>

IT IS ORDERED that the document received on April 26, 2023, shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of April 4, 2023. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat.

§§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by July 3, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed; and

IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that in this instance only, the clerk of this court shall redact the April 26, 2023 nonconforming petition so only G.M.I.'s initials are visible. G.M.I. is reminded that in the statement in support of the petition for review the confidentiality rules applicable to termination of parental rights cases must be adhered to. In order to comply with the applicable confidentiality rules, G.M.I. must perform the following:

- in all future filings only refer to parent and child by their initials;
- file one copy of the statement in support of the petition for review with G.M.I.'s full, unredacted signature, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted; i.e., redacted to show only the initials of the parents and child, in such a manner that the text underneath the redactions cannot be read. This copy will be placed in the court's confidential file;
- file nine additional copies of the statement in support with G.M.I.'s signature properly redacted, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted;
- serve on opposing counsel one copy of the statement in support with G.M.I.'s signature properly redacted, and with an appendix that has the parents' and child's names properly redacted

Failure to adhere to the above rules may cause future filings to be stricken and the instant appeal to be dismissed.
