The court of appeals issued its final decision in this matter on March 23, 2023, which it declined to reconsider by order of April 18, 2023. A petition for review conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62 was due within 30 days of the court of appeals' decision on the motion for reconsideration. See Wis. State. § 808.10(2). Consequently, the deadline for filing a petition for review in this matter was May 18, 2023. At 4:29 p.m., on May 18, 2023, defendant-appellant, Joan Noback, pro se, sent, via facsimile transmission, a copy of a petition for review.

Petitions for review: (1) must comply with Wis. Stat. §§ (Rules) 809.62(1) and 809.81; (2) must be accompanied by the required \$195 filing fee, unless waived; and (3) must be physically

filed with the clerk of the supreme court within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' final decision or, as applicable here, within 30 days of a decision on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80. Because petitions for review require a filing fee, they may not be filed by facsimile. Wis. Stat. § 801.16(2).

IT IS ORDERED that the non-complying petition for review filed by facsimile is dismissed, without costs.
