On May 23, 2023, this court received a faxed, unsigned letter from Sidney L. Graham, in which he states that he “want[s] to appeal the decision that was made on 4-26-2023” and asks “for a 90 day extension to respond to this decision.”

Having construed this letter as a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals’ decision of April 26, 2023;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Moreover, this motion cannot itself be accepted for filing as a petition for review capable of supplementation by a supporting statement. are governed by Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62, must be signed per Wis. Stat. § 802.05(1), and may not be filed by fax or email. To the extent that Mr. Graham intends to file a petition for review in this matter, a paper copy of the petition must be physically received in the Clerk's office within 30 days of the date of the court of appeals' decision; i.e., by May 26, 2023. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.80.
