**ORDER FOLLOWING HEARING ON MOTION FOR  
PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

On July 26, 2021 at 9:00 a.m., an on the record electronic hearing was held regarding OLR's motion for partial summary judgment. The Office of Lawyer Regulation appeared by Attorney Kim Kluck. The respondent, Khaja Din appeared in person and by Attorney James Bartzen. For the reasons stated on the record,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. OLR's motion for summary judgment as to Count 1 is denied.
2. OLR's motion for summary judgment as to Count 4 is denied.
3. OLR's motion for summary judgment as to Count 3 is granted.


Subsequent to the hearing on OLR's motion for partial summary judgement, a scheduling conference was held.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. OLR is to provide the referee and opposing counsel with a list of their anticipated witnesses on or before September 10, 2021.
2. Respondent is to provide the referee and opposing counsel with a list of their anticipated witnesses on or before October 11, 2021.

3. All Discovery is to be completed by October 25, 2021.
4. The parties are to file with the referee on or before November 1, 2021 a complete list of exhibits sequentially numbered from 1 to end (without designation as to complainant or respondent's exhibit).
5. The hearing on this matter is to commence on November 8, 2021. It is anticipated that the matter will take three days to complete. OLR and Mr. Bartzen will work together in an attempt to locate a place in Cook County for the hearing.
