The court having considered the motions of defendant-appellant, Charles Brown, pro se, for waiver of the required number of copies of his petition for review and for an order allowing the payment of the filing fees from his release account, and noting that any petition for review filed in this case must be filed by July 14, 2023;

IT IS ORDERED that, in order to maintain jurisdiction, the defendant-appellant's June 26, 2023 filing is construed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' June 14, 2023 decision. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by August 14, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for waiver of the required number of copies is granted. Mr. Brown may file one original copy of his statement in support of the petition for review; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for an order allowing the payment of the filing fees from his release account is denied. Section 814.29(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes sets forth the procedure that anyone other than a "prisoner" as defined in Wis. Stat. § 801.02(7)(a)2 is required to follow in order to file a petition for review without prepaying the filing fee or giving security for costs. For purposes of this action, petitioner does not qualify as a "prisoner" under Wis. Stat. § 801.02(7)(a)2, and therefore Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1) applies. (A copy of Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1) is being attached to petitioner's copy of this order.). On or before August 14, 2023, Mr. Brown shall pay the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for waiving the prepayment of the filing fee by filing the Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs-Affidavit of Indigency that is being sent to Mr. Brown with his copy of this order. Wis. Stat. § 814.29(1)(b). If that completed document is returned to the clerk of this court by the specified time, this court will determine whether petitioner is entitled to file his petition for review without the prepayment of the filing fee.
