You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2021AP1104-CRNM State v. Hall L.C.# 2018CF207

The court having considered the motion of defendant-appellant, David Hall, pro se, to extend the time in which to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of May 17, 2023, which the court of appeals declined to reconsider by order dated June 7, 2023, and the motion for waiver of the required number of copies of the petition for review;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979); and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review. A statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by August 7, 2023. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for waiver of the required number of copies is dismissed as moot. Effective July 1, 2023, paper filers in the supreme court are required to submit just a single copy of each filing to the clerk of this court. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.80(1). Consequently, defendant-appellant may file one copy of his statement in support of the petition for review on or before August 7, 2023. Defendant-appellant is reminded, however, that he remains solely responsible for serving a copy of his statement in support of the petition for review on the Attorney General, as the clerk of this court is neither required nor authorized to serve papers on behalf of litigants.
